Welcome and Introduction of Special Guests

- Superintendent Doug Eccarius- thank you to PTCS for all you do to support school and students.
 - The focus of past board meetings was assessment and instruction-looking from lowest to highest to get a gauge. The next meeting is less of this.
 - Construction- all schools had some last summer. This summer- major work at Briar Glen and getting a later start with emergency days used.
 - Some construction with Parking lots- Arbor View and Glen Crest
 - Some seal coating- ParkView- major parking lot work will be over the next few years. when asked for bonds, didn't realize how much prices would increase. Briar Glen is serious.
 - Calendar Survey- Strongly encourage all to fill out. We really wanted opinions on Thanksgiving week. Elearning has become controversial and we want to know if the flexibility of elearning, if needed, and is good option to have. I.e. put one day of Eleaerning on file to have flexibility... in case we have to make up lots of emergency days and it pushed the calendar like this year.
 - For this year, the board is discussing ideas for getting the last day (now Monday) to be replaced with a day off planned for April
 - Lots of Policies and Press Policies- how we operationalize procedures. most is from LAW, so many law changes- schools are getting hit hard. i.e. NarCan is school. Opioid antagonist on supply- lots of high schools- all schools have to and had to do training. This was also offered to D89 Bball.
 - Talking 89 sessions- Feb 22nd-morning and evening- safety and family involvement- did same talking sessions at schools- could chat with staff too. "Soup"erintendent meeting- Been in many classrooms and mystery reader at PV
 - Substitute Challenge- not just our area- widespread nationwide. There is also a nationwide teacher shortage- baby boomers retiring and not enough to fill those positions- most of new teachers are getting hired, hence fewer subs.
 - Pep SubCommittee- fully segmented funds for Supplies for Success-
 - Incubator program- South, 8th graders leaving GC going to South- Incubator-like Shark tank- new program with PEP.
 - doing more hands-on programs with trades-- etc.
 - The District is wrestling with Chronic absenteeism- any students who miss 10% of school year is in state data.

- % of students miss 10% of school year. state is 25-27%. we were at 12% year prior. Trying to communicate with families the best way to manage vacations, etc at other times. still held accountable for growth and performance.
- Assessments- we want to be 85% above 40%- looked at fall to winter growth across the board- saw amazing growth with math, just not the same in reading.
- 2nd-grade teacher here is a leader around Assessments-- Hornig is a leader.
